Booth Site Participant Terms & Conditions

A. PREFACE

1. **Event.** The No Kings 3 Protest March and Rally (hereafter the “Event”) will take place on Saturday, March 28, 2026, in Fayetteville. At 10:00 am, attendees will march from the intersection of Dickson Street and Highland towards the Upper Ramble, where a rally will take place until 1:00 pm.
2. **Binding Effect.** By submitting an application and paying the required fee for reserving a booth site at the Event, the Participant acknowledges and accepts the terms and conditions of this Agreement, which shall be binding upon its officers, employees, volunteers, and contractors. Participant shall ensure they will abide by all rules and instructions concerning the booth site and the Event.

B. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **No Transfer of Authorization.** The fees and booth sites are nontransferable, and no booth site may be reassigned to another person or entity without the express written permission of Indivisible Northwest Arkansas (hereafter INWA).
2. **Right to Participate Is Revocable.** INWA retains the right to remove any person or entity from the Event area if its actions jeopardize the Event’s safety or the safety of attendees.
3. **Clean Up.** Each Participant is required to have at the booth site trash bags for depositing trash and litter accumulated before, during, and after the Event, and to remove said trash bags and leave the booth site free of debris at the conclusion of the Event.
4. **Extreme Weather Policy.** In the event of extreme weather conditions, including rain, INWA reserves the right to cancel or modify the Event. In the event of a cancellation after March 26, 2026, fees for booth sites cannot be refunded.
5. **Mandatory Mediation.** Any dispute between Participant and INWA related to this Agreement, or to Participant’s participation in the Event, that exceeds the jurisdiction of small claims court, shall first be submitted to mediation to be held in the City of Fayetteville, Arkansas. Disputes not resolved in mediation shall be submitted to a court of competent jurisdiction.

6. Attorney's Fees. Each party shall bear the costs of its own attorney's fees and expenses incurred in connection with any mediation or legal action. In the event of any legal proceeding, the prevailing party shall reserve the right to seek the recovery of its attorney's fees.

7. Force Majeure. INWA shall not be liable for a delay in the Event or in the performance of its obligations under this Agreement due to causes beyond its control, including, without limitation, weather, or other Force Majeure event. In such eventuality, INWA shall have no obligation to reschedule or to refund any fees paid in connection with this Agreement.

8. Governing Law. This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted under the laws of the state of Arkansas, without reference to its conflicts of law provisions, and the venue shall be in Fayetteville, Arkansas.

9. Severability. Should any court with jurisdiction determine that any provision of this Agreement is illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, the remainder of the Agreement shall be enforced to the fullest extent possible to reflect the parties' intent.

10. No Verbal Modifications. Any deviation from the terms of this Agreement requires confirmation in writing.

C. BOOTH SITE GUIDELINES

1. Fee. The fee for each booth space is \$250.00 (Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars). This fee is the same for EVERYONE, including nonprofit organizations, individuals, corporate entities, or professional associations.

2. Location. Booth sites will be located on the Upper Ramble, at the southwest intersection of Dixon Street and West Avenue. The location of Participant's booth will be at INWA's sole discretion. All booth sites are approximately 10' x 10.' Participant must bring all materials needed for setting up the assigned booth site: canopy, weights, table, chairs, etc. There will be access to power outlets. Nonetheless, make sure to have an extension cable (25ft-50ft) to connect if your booth requires power.

3. Set Up. The set-up time for the Event will be: 8:00 AM. You may arrive earlier if you wish. You may park alongside West Avenue, between Dickson Street and Spring Street, just long enough to drop off set-up materials, and then must remove promptly all vehicles and trailers from West Avenue, in no event later than 9:00 am. Dickson Street, West Avenue, and other streets will be closed until 12 noon, and no parking of vehicles will be allowed. Vehicles parked on closed streets will be towed at owner's expense. You will receive a map with the layout of the Event and the location of your booth site. The INDIVISIBLE NWA TENT will be an INFORMATION BOOTH. Go there if you have any questions or concerns.

4. No Sales. No sales of any kind will be allowed at the booths, only free distribution of materials and information.
